Document work done from May 15 through May 14 for a period of one (1) Year only. Send entry in duplicate no later than **May 1<sup>st</sup>**.

**WHO:** Who judges? The committee members are all the past winners of the award. They are fair in their judging as they want someone to be as honored and privileged as they were to earn the Ladies Auxiliary of the year award.

**NOTE:** To all Ladies Auxiliary members. Don't think you don't have a person to qualify. Send in a Ladies Auxiliary member's name and let the committee be the judge.

**The winner should be present at the Department of Ohio Convention Banquet, to receive the Outstanding Member Award.**

Send entries to the Department Headquarters by May 1<sup>st</sup>. This award is judged by PDP Barb McCrory and Committee at the Department Convention.
